Definitions

- **Consequences**: the costs and benefits to society resulting from a decision *Goal: maximizing net benefits*
- **Principles**: statements concerning the absolute rightness or goodness of an action *Goal: fulfilling principles*
- **Rights**: fundamental aspects of life to which people are entitled *Goal: maintaining or enhancing rights*
- **Character**: the sum of traits that are seen as good or not good for an individual to possess *Goal: to maintain and exhibit good traits*
- **Social contract**: the rules agreed upon, explicitly or implicitly, by members of a society *Goal: to maintain and enhance the security and fairness in society*
- **Relationships**: the connections, natural, intentional, or accidental, of one human being with another

Goal: to maintain and strengthen relationships

Duties: the specific imperatives given by specific actions of oneself or others *Goal: the fulfill duties as far as possible*
