- 7. Is female circumcision a women's rights issue? Reading through the WHO Fact Sheet 241 (2012), would be correct to describe female circumcision as a medical issue and not a human rights problem? What is PLAN's position on F/G/C? How does PLAN characterize F/G/C? Cultural issue? Health/medical issue? Human rights issue? Is PLAN's plan of action an acceptable way of dealing with F/G/C? What are the five "essential points" following from UNICEF's statistical exploration of the issue? (Alston & Goodman, pp. 562-568)
- 8. Why did opponents of F/G/C abandon health arguments as a framework for opposing F/G/C? As an alternative, the anti-F/G/C campaign has embraced the human rights framework. What rights, according to these campaigners are infringed by the F/G/C practice? What are the problems with this approach? Why is consent a big issue with F/G/C, especially that other body modification procedures are not held to similarly exceptionally high standards? What strategies might be helpful in reducing the incidence of F/G/C in countries with high prevalence rates if there is any need for that?
