Attendance and Participation

You do not need to submit anything here unless you attended remotely or were absent from this class period.

These points will be awarded if you attend class and participate in the various activities.

If you attend remotely, make sure I know you are in class, and make sure you are an active participant - this means you engage in discussions with your group as well as participating in other activities. It helps to have your camera on whenever possible. This will earn you partial credit. To receive full credit for the day, you will need to submit evidence that you engaged in class activities. (Notes, mathematical work, etc.)

If you miss class, you can make up these points. Do the following:

- · Check in with someone who was in class. Find out what you missed.
- Go over the PowerPoint from the missed class.
- Watch any available mini-lectures that cover content from the missed class.
- Submit evidence that you are now familiar with the content from the class you missed. You get to choose what that evidence is it could be a written summary of the content, an audio or video submission, picture of your notes, etc.
- Make sure you also submit (via this assignment) any in-class work that you missed.
